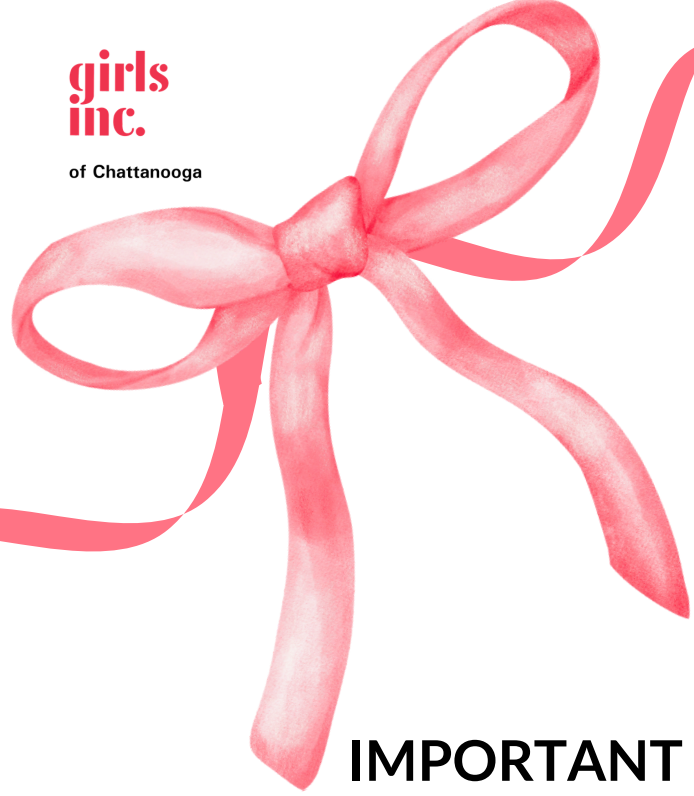
Option 3: Drop off your written essay in the designated basket at the program building. Ask a Coordinator for directions.

IMPORTANT RULES TO REMEMBER

- **NO PLAGIARISM** - Don't copy from books, websites, or other people. Use your own words and ideas - we want to hear from YOU! Plagiarism is when you take someone else's words or ideas and pretend they're your own. Even if you find something you like online, you must say it in your own way!
- **NO ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI)** - Your work should come from your own mind and heart, not a computer or chatbot. We're celebrating your unique voice!
- **NO PROFANITY** - Exclude any inappropriate content.
- The essay or video **must answer the prompt question clearly and be the minimum length expected for the participant's age group** unless the girl has special needs and requires accommodations. Essays and videos that do not meet the time or length expectations will automatically be disqualified. It is okay for the video or essay to exceed the minimum requirements.

Don't wait; start today! Turn in your video or essay by June 30 to be considered for this exciting opportunity and bring your vision to life.
